1. Before the tutoring session, select a photograph from the sports section of the newspaper that shows emotion (“the thrill of victory” or “the agony of defeat”). Ask him how he thinks the person in the photo feels, what the person was doing just before the picture was taken, and which sport the person was playing.
2. Ask him to imagine that he is a TV reporter and is going to interview the athlete in the photo. Have him write some questions he would like to ask the athlete in his journal.
3. Read the questions back to him. Using a paper or aluminum foil “microphone”, let him read the questions to me, as if he were the reporter. I’ll answer as if I were the athlete being interviewed.
4. On index cards, write words related to the sport the athlete plays. Make two cards for each word. Put the cards face down on the table and let him choose one, then try to find the matching card. If he selects the wrong card, he must put both cards back and it’s my turn. If he chooses a match, he continues playing. Take turns until all cards have been matched.
5. Choose any book about sports or a sports figure. Before reading it, look at the pictures. Ask him to name the sports equipment in the pictures. Talk about other sports he knows. Read the book together. Use post-it notes to label the sports and equipment in the story.
6. Review previous journal entries. Are there any about sports?
